POINT NO POINT TREATY COUNCIL IN-COMMON FALL CHUM SALMON REGULATIONS #F19-029

These regulations shall apply to Jamestown and Port Gamble S'Klallam off-reservation commercial fisheries for early fall chum salmon in the in-common management areas described below.

Areas and times not specifically opened by or listed in these regulations remain closed to commercial fisheries for chum salmon, until further notice.

SECTION I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

TOPIC 1. IN COMMON MANAGEMENT AREAS

These regulations shall apply to the following areas by Tribe:

- a) Jamestown S'Klallam and Port Gamble S'Klallam:
Areas 4B, 5, 6, 6A, 6B, 6C, 6D (outside the exclusive harvest demarcation line), 7, 9, 12, 12A, 12B.
- b) Jamestown S'Klallam: 6D (inshore of the exclusive harvest demarcation line).

TOPIC 2. LAWFUL GEAR

Marine drift gillnets – Minimum stretched mesh 5” inches in all areas; maximum length as specified in Tribal Ordinances.

Marine setnets – Minimum stretched mesh 5” inches in all areas; maximum length 150 fms. (900 ft), except in Area 6D the maximum length is 100 fms (600 ft).

Beach seines – Maximum length 165 fms., Maximum depth 200 meshes, Minimum mesh size 3”, Maximum mesh size 4”).

Hand held gear – Hook-and-line, dipnets, snaglines, gaffs as specified in Tribal Ordinances.

TOPIC 3. EARLY FALL CHUM SALMON MANAGEMENT PERIODS

- a) Areas 4B, 5, 6C: October 13 through November 9
- b) Areas 6, 7: October 13 through November 16
- c) Area 6A: October 13 through November 16
- d) Area 6B: October 13 through November 23
- e) Area 9: October 13 through November 23
- f) Area 6D: October 27 through November 30
- g) Area 12A: October 13 through November 20
- h) Area 12: October 13 through November 20
- i) Area 12B: October 21 through November 20

SECTION II. FISHERY OPENINGS

TOPIC 1. Areas 4B, 5, 6C

May be opened from 10/13 through 11/9; Openings shall be announced by inseason regulations.

TOPIC 2. Areas 6, 7

Openings shall be announced by emergency regulations based on inseason harvest management considerations under provisions of the PST Annex for chum salmon.

TOPIC 3. Areas 6A, 6B, 6D

Closed throughout the management period, except the Area 6D coho fishery (managed under separate regulations) may be extended into the beginning of the 6D chum management period when in-season conditions permit.

TOPIC 4. Areas 12, 12A (south of an E-W line through Pt. Whitney)

May be opened from 10/13 through 11/20; Openings shall be announced by inseason regulations.

TOPIC 5. Area 12B

May be opened from 10/20 through 11/20, except north of an east-west line from Zelatched Point to Seal Rock open through 11/27; Openings shall be announced by inseason regulations.

TOPIC 6. Area 9

Openings shall be announced by inseason regulations.

SECTION III. SPECIAL CLOSURES AND REQUIREMENTS

- 1) No marine nets may be operated closer than 1,000 feet from any stream or river mouth that is not open to fishing. The river mouth shall be defined at the point where the stream enters the sea at mean low tide. At Big Beef Creek, no marine nets may be operated within 1,500 feet from the river mouth, which shall be defined by the Seabeck Highway crossing.
- 2) The area within 1/4 mile from the mouth of the Pysht River shall be closed to net fisheries whenever that river is closed to commercial harvest.
- 3) Fishers who operate gillnet gear (drift and/or set) in Hood Canal Areas 12, 12A, or 12B are required to have and use logbooks provided by their Tribal Fisheries office.

SECTION IV. EMERGENCY REGULATIONS


Openings and restrictions outlined in these regulations may be modified at any time by emergency regulation based on inseason management considerations.

SECTION V. EXPECTED EFFORT AND HARVEST

- a) Expected effort is being submitted separately by each member Tribe.
- b) The member Tribes intend to fully harvest their lawful share of chum salmon.

SECTION VI. AUTHORITY

The above regulations are promulgated by the Point No Point Treaty Council under authority delegated by its member Tribes.
