OTHER RESTRICTIONS:

AS PER ANNUAL HALIBUT REGULATION #F22-002;

A FISHER MAY HARVEST HALIBUT WITH A 500 POUND LIMIT PER VESSEL PER 24-HOUR PERIOD; ANY PORTION OF LANDED CATCH (UP TO 100 POUNDS) THAT EXCEEDS THE LANDING LIMIT MUST BE DELIVERED TO THE TRIBE FOR CEREMONIAL PURPOSES;

A 24 HOUR PERIOD IS MIDNIGHT TO MIDNIGHT;

A LANDING LIMIT IS THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF COMMERCIAL CATCH FROM A SINGLE VESSEL, AFTER BEING PERSONALLY HARVESTED BY THAT VESSEL'S CREW, WHICH MAY BE OFFLOADED FROM THE VESSEL TO A SHORE-BASED FACILITY OR BUYER IN A SINGLE CALENDAR DAY;

NO HALIBUT MAY BE TRANSFERRED FROM ONE VESSEL TO ANOTHER, INCLUDING TO A TENDER VESSEL, OR BE REPORTED AS LANDED FROM A VESSEL OTHER THAN THE VESSEL THAT HARVESTED IT, AS PER THE MANAGEMENT MEASURES FOR THE TREATY HALIBUT FISHERY;

LINGCOD BYCATCH MAY BE RETAINED AND COMMERCIALY SOLD ACCORDING TO THE LANDING LIMITS BELOW; COMMERCIAL SIZE LIMITS AND OTHER REGULATIONS APPLY (SEE PNPTC BOTTOMFISH REGULATION F20-010 FOR OTHER COMMERCIAL AND C&S LINGCOD RESTRICTIONS).

ALL AREAS: LINGCOD MAY BE RETAINED FOR SUBSISTENCE (C&S) ACCORDING TO THE LIMITS IN TOPIC 13(e) OF THE PNPTC BOTTOM FISH REGULATION F20-010;

AREA 29: LINGCOD MAY BE RETAINED AND COMMERCIALY SOLD (NO LIMIT);

AREA 23C: THE FIRST 10 LINGCOD LANDED (NOT INCLUDING C&S);

AREAS 20B, 22A, 23A, 23B, 23D, 25A, 25B, 25C, 25D, 25E, 27A, AND 27B: THE FIRST 4 LINGCOD LANDED (NOT INCLUDING C&S).

EXPECTED EFFORT: UP TO 26 BOATS FOR THE PORT GAMBLE SKLALLAM TRIBE.

JUSTIFICATION (S) HARVEST OF TRIBAL SHARE OF HALIBUT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE IPHC, PFMC, AND THE TRIBAL HALIBUT FISHERY MANAGEMENT PLAN.
