OTHER RESTRICTIONS

1. THIS REGULATION OPENS UP SUBSISTENCE HARVEST OF ALL OTHER INTERTIDAL SPECIES (PACIFIC OYSTER, MANAILA CLAMS, LITTLENECK CLAMS, BUTTERS, HORSE CLAMS, GEODUCK AND MUSSELS)
2. HARVEST LIMITS AND RESTRICTIONS FOR OPEN SPECIES AS PER PGST REGULTION #S21-10, SECTIONS 4-7.

JUSTIFICATION:

PSP CLOSURE HAS BEEN LIFTED FOR ALL SHELLFISH SPECIES IN PORT GAMBLE BAY. ALL COCKLE HARVEST ON RESERVATION TIDELANDS REMAIN CLOSED DUE INTERTIDAL SHELLFISH DIE-OFF. THE DIE OFF IS ASSUMED TO BE CAUSED BY EXTREME HEAT DURING LOW TIDE.
