A FISHER MAY HARVEST HALIBUT WITH A 500 POUND
LIMIT PER VESSEL PER 24-HOUR PERIOD;

A 24 HOUR PERIOD IS MIDNIGHT TO MIDNIGHT;

A LANDING LIMIT IS THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF COMMERCIAL
CATCH FROM A SINGLE VESSEL, AFTER BEING
PERSONALLY

HARVESTED BY THAT VESSEL'S CREW, WHICH MAY BE
OFFLOADED FROM THE VESSEL TO A SHORE-BASED
FACILITY OR BUYER IN A SINGLE CALENDAR DAY;

NO HALIBUT MAY BE TRANSFERRED FROM ONE VESSEL TO
TO ANOTHER, INCLUDING TO A TENDER VESSEL, OR BE
REPORTED AS LANDED FROM A VESSEL OTHER THAN THE
VESSEL THAT HARVESTED IT, AS PER THE MANAGEMENT
MEASURES FOR THE TREATY HALIBUT FISHERY.

EXPECTED EFFORT: UP TO 7 BOATS FOR THE JAMESTOWN SKLALLAM TRIBE.

JUSTIFICATION (S) HARVEST OF TRIBAL SHARE OF HALIBUT IN
ACCORDANCE WITH THE IPHC, PFMC, AND THE
TRIBAL HALIBUT FISHERY MANAGEMENT PLAN.
