FOR THE PORT GAMBLE TRIBE ONLY, THE COMMERCIAL SALE OF CATCH TO INDIVIDUALS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERSONAL CONSUMPTION (“ROADSIDE” OR “BEACHSIDE” SALE) IS AUTHORIZED AND SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS:

1. ALL CATCH MUST BE RECORDED ON FISH TICKETS OR ROADSIDE SALE REPORTING FORMS;
2. ALL CATCHES AND SALES MUST BE RECORDED AND REPORTED TO THE PORT GAMBLE FISHERIES OFFICE WITHIN 24 HOURS OF LANDING;
3. SALES TO INDIVIDUALS FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESALE ARE PROHIBITED.

JAMESTOWN TRIBAL MEMBERS SHALL CONTINUE TO FOLLOW THE PROCESS AUTHORIZED UNDER TITLE 6 (FISHING CODE) OF THE JAMESTOWN S’KLALLAM TRIBAL CODE AND ANY OTHER APPLICABLE JAMESTOWN TRIBAL LAWS.

JUSTIFICATION (S): AUTHORIZE ROADSIDE/BEACHSIDE SALES FOR THE PORT GAMBLE S’KLALLAM TRIBE.
