OTHER RESTRICTIONS:

AS PER ANNUAL HALIBUT REGULATION #F22-002;

NO MORE THAN 1,500 CUMULATIVE POUNDS PER VESSEL MAY BE LANDED OVER THE DURATION OF THIS FISHERY; ANY PORTION OF LANDED CATCH (UP TO 100 POUNDS) THAT EXCEEDS THE CUMULATIVE LANDING LIMIT MUST BE DELIVERED TO THE TRIBE FOR C&S PURPOSES;

LANDING LIMIT IS THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF COMMERCIAL CATCH FROM A SINGLE VESSEL OVER THE DURATION OF THE FISHERY (72 HOURS), AFTER BEING PERSONALLY HARVESTED BY THAT VESSEL'S CREW;

LANDED CATCH FROM NO MORE THAN ONE VESSEL MAY BE PLACED ON A SINGLE FISH TICKET, I.E. CATCH FROM MULTIPLE BOATS MAY NOT BE RECORDED ON A SINGLE TICKET;

NO HALIBUT MAY BE TRANSFERRED FROM ONE VESSEL TO ANOTHER, INCLUDING TO A TENDER VESSEL, OR BE REPORTED AS LANDED FROM A VESSEL OTHER THAN THE VESSEL THAT HARVESTED IT, AS PER THE MANAGEMENT MEASURES FOR THE TREATY HALIBUT FISHERY.

EXPECTED EFFORT: UP TO 26 BOATS FOR THE PORT GAMBLE SKLALLAM TRIBE.

JUSTIFICATION (S): HARVEST OF TRIBAL SHARE OF HALIBUT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE IPHC, PFMC, AND THE TRIBAL HALIBUT FISHERY MANAGEMENT PLAN.
