A FISHER MAY HARVEST HALIBUT WITHOUT A LANDING LIMIT;

FISHERS MUST REGISTER WITH THE JAMESTOWN NATURAL RESOURCES OFFICE PRIOR TO PARTICIPATING IN THE HALIBUT FISHERY.

JAMESTOWN TRIBAL BUYERS MUST RETURN COMPLETED FISH TICKETS INTO JAMESTOWN'S FISHERIES OFFICE NO LATER THAN 6 DAYS FOLLOWING COMMERCIAL HARVEST.

EXPECTED EFFORT: UP TO 7 BOATS FOR THE JAMESTOWN S'KLALLAM TRIBE.

JUSTIFICATION (S): HARVEST OF TRIBAL SHARE OF HALIBUT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE IPHC, PFMC, AND THE TRIBAL HALIBUT FISHERY MANAGEMENT PLAN.
