HARVEST RESTRICTIONS:

1. THIS FISHERY WILL BE CONDUCTED BY THE JAMESTOWN S'KLALLAM TRIBE ONLY.
2. ONE BOAT WILL PARTICIPATE IN THE FISHERY. THE FISHER WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:
  - a. JESSE HOLDEN – VESSEL #WN-311-JST
3. THE TARGET HARVEST FOR THIS FISHERY IS 300 POUNDS.

LEGAL GEAR:

1. AS PER REGULATIONS #S23-057 SECTIONS 7 & 8.
2. THE MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE TOTAL NUMBER OF POTS FOR THIS FISHERY IS 15 PER VESSEL.
3. LONGLINE FISHING IS PERMITTED. A MAXIMUM OF 5 POTS PER LONGLINE IS ALLOWED.

CATCH REPORTING:

ALL CEREMONIAL CATCHES SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE JAMESTOWN FISHERIES OFFICE AFTER CLOSURE OF THE FISHERY.
