HARVEST RESTRICTIONS:

1. THIS FISHERY WILL BE CONDUCTED BY THE JAMESTOWN S'KLALLAM TRIBE ONLY.
2. ONE BOAT WILL PARTICIPATE IN THE FISHERY. THE FISHER WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:
 - a. JESSE HOLDEN – VESSEL ID #WN-311-JST
3. THE TARGET HARVEST FOR THIS FISHERY IS 400 POUNDS.

LEGAL GEAR:

1. THE MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE TOTAL NUMBER OF POTS FOR THIS FISHERY IS 20.
2. LONGLINE FISHING IS PERMITTED. A MAXIMUM OF 5 POTS PER LONGLINE IS ALLOWED.

CATCH REPORTING:

ALL CEREMONIAL CATCHES SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE JAMESTOWN FISHERIES OFFICE AFTER CLOSURE OF THE FISHERY.

JUSTIFICATION:

HARVEST FOR CEREMONIAL NEEDS. THIS REGULATION SETS A NEW START DAY FOR THE CEREMONIAL REGULATION DUE TO WEATHER.
