Effective Dates: May 10, 2022 through April 30, 2023.

Days/Hours: Open 7 days per week.

Other Restrictions: The following restrictions and regulations shall be in effect:

1. All salmon and steelhead bearing rivers and streams closed March 1 through May 31, unless open by PNPTC salmon subsistence reg. F22-014;
2. Fishers are required to be in possession of their Treaty Indian identification card and current finfish subsistence card;
3. All catch must be reported to the fisheries department;
4. Tribal fishing codes.

Justification(s): Provide tribal subsistence harvest.
