ON/OFF RESERVATION: BOTH.

LAWFUL GEAR: HAND HELD GEAR (HOOK AND LINE, DIP-NET, ETC.).

EFFECTIVE DATES: MAY 1, 2026 THROUGH APRIL 30, 2027.

DAYS/HOURS: OPEN 7 DAYS PER WEEK.

OTHER RESTRICTIONS: THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS AND REGULATIONS SHALL BE IN EFFECT:

1. FISHERS ARE REQUIRED TO BE IN POSSESSION OF THEIR TREATY INDIAN IDENTIFICATION CARD AND CURRENT SUBSISTENCE CATCH REPORTING CARD;
2. ALL CATCH MUST BE RECORDED ON A SUBSISTENCE CATCH REPORTING CARD;
3. ALL SALMON AND STEELHEAD BEARING RIVERS AND STREAMS CLOSED MARCH 1 THROUGH JUNE 15, UNLESS OPEN FOR SALMON SUBSISTENCE BY REG. F26-008;
4. TRIBAL FISHING CODES.

JUSTIFICATION(S): PROVIDE TRIBAL SUBSISTENCE HARVEST.
