CATCH AREAS: 20A (SOUTH AND WEST OF A LINE BETWEEN TOE POINT ON PATOS ISLAND AND POINT MIGLEY ON LUMMI ISLAND), 20B, 21A (SOUTH AND WEST OF LUMMI ISLAND AND A LINE RUNNING BETWEEN CARTER POINT ON LUMMI ISLAND AND THE NORTHER TIP OF VENDОВI ISLAND), 22A, 22B (NORTH AND WEST OF A LINE BETWEEN CLARK POINT ON GUEMES ISLAND AND THE SOUTHERN TIP OF VENDОВI ISLAND, WEST OF GUEMES ISLAND AND SOUTH AND WEST OF A LINE RUNNING DUE SOUTH FROM KELLY'S POINT ON GUEMES ISLAND), 23A, 23B, 23C, 23D, 25A, 25B, 25C, 25D, 25E, 26A WEST (S'KLALLAM U&A AREAS IN THAT PORTION OF 26A SOUTH AND WEST OF THE SOUTHERN TIP OF POSSESSION POINT ON WHIDBEY ISLAND), 27A, 27B (NORTH OF AN EAST-WEST LINE FROM AYOCK PT.), 29.

FISHERY TYPE: COMMERCIAL AND SUBSISTENCE

SPECIES: OPAL SQUID (*Loligo opalescens*)

ON/OFF RESERVATION: OFF

EFFECTIVE DATES: AUGUST 1, 2021 THROUGH JULY 31, 2022.

DAYS AND HOURS: COMMERCIAL AND SUBSISTENCE SQUID FISHERIES FOR THE PORT GAMBLE AND JAMESTOWN S'KLALLAM TRIBES WILL BE OPEN CONTINUOUSLY THROUGHOUT THE TERM OF THIS REGULATION, SUBJECT TO EMERGENCY MODIFICATION.

LEGAL GEAR:

1. LEGAL COMMERCIAL GEAR SHALL INCLUDE DIP BAG, BRAIL, SQUID JIGGING GEAR, HERRING RAKE, OR OTHER GEAR AS PROVIDED BY EMERGENCY MODIFICATION. DIP BAG NET AND BRAIL MAY NOT HAVE A MESH LESS THAN 1-INCH STRETCH MEASURE.
2. DRAG SEINE, BEACH SEINE, AND SMELT DRAG BAN NET GEAR ARE PROHIBITED.
3. EACH VESSEL FISHING FOR SQUID MAY USE A LIGHTING SYSTEM WITH A COMBINED POWER OF NO MORE THAN 30 KILOWATTS. LIGHTS OF 200 WATTS OR GREATER MUST BE SHIELDED AND

MAY NOT BE DIRECTED TO ANY POINT MORE THAN 100 FEET FROM THE FISHING SITE WHILE FISHING OR ATTRACTING SQUID.

OTHER RESTRICTIONS:

1. THE SUBSISTENCE DAILY CATCH LIMIT IS 10 POUNDS OF SQUID PER FISHER.
2. SQUID EGGS AND EGG MASSES CAUGHT WHILE FISHING FOR SQUID MUST BE RETURNED TO THE WATER IMMEDIATELY.

CATCH REPORTING:

1. FISHERS ARE REQUIRED TO RECORD ALL COMMERCIAL HARVEST ON FISH RECEIVING TICKETS. HARVEST DATA WILL BE COMPILED AND EXCHANGED WITH ALL AFFECTED PARTIES ANNUALLY. HARVEST DATA WILL BE PROVIDED WITHIN TWO WEEKS WHEN REQUESTED BY AN AFFECTED PARTY.
2. ALL CATCH MUST BE RECORDED ON HARVEST LOGS AND REPORTED TO THE FISHERIES OFFICE ON A MONTHLY BASIS.
3. DAILY HARVEST INFORMATION MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - a. DATE OF HARVEST
  - b. VESSEL NAME OR BOAT REGISTRATION NUMBER
  - c. LOCATION (LANDMARK OR GPS) AND CATCH AREA FISHED
  - d. POUNDS LANDED
  - e. GEAR TYPE
  - f. AVERAGE DEPTH OF HARVEST
  - g. TOTAL WATTAGE OF ATTRACTING LIGHTS
  - h. INCIDENTAL CATCH
  - i. DURATION FISHED
4. ALL SUBSISTENCE HARVEST SHALL BE REPORTED ON SHELLFISH SUBSISTENCE CARDS. CARDS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE TRIBAL FISHERIES OFFICE.

JUSTIFICATION:

HARVEST AVAILABLE SQUID RESOURCE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 2017-2022 PUGET SOUND SQUID HARVEST MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT.

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
