## POINT NO POINT SECTION 4.6 OYSTER REGULATION FOR REGION 8

The following regulation is promulgated by the Point No Point Treaty Council and shall govern the commercial oyster fisheries conducted off-reservation and on inter-tidal public lands within Region 8 by the Port Gamble S'Klallam and the Jamestown S'Klallam Tribes (PNPTC member Tribes). The term of this regulation is from January 1 through December 31, 2025, and is intended to regulate the oyster harvest by these member Tribes in Region 8 under provisions of Paragraph 4.6 of the U.S. District Court Order of August 28, 1995 (Implementation Order) in U.S. v Washington, Sub-proceeding 89-3. In the event the Region 8 Bivalve Management Plan is completed before the end of this regulation term, this regulation will be superseded by a new regulation conforming to the provisions of the Region 8 Bivalve Management Plan.
