ON/OFF RESERVATION: OFF

LAWFUL GEAR: ROD & REEL – ONE HAND-HELD ROD & REEL PER PERSON, NO MORE
THAN 2 HOOKS. NO SNAG GEAR, NO SNAGGING - EGGS &
SPINNER/SPOON GEAR ONLY. SINGLE POINT BARBLESS HOOKS. (HOOKS
LESS THAN ½ INCH FROM POINT TO SHANK).

EFFECTIVE DATES: NOVEMBER 9, 2024 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2024.

DAYS/HOURS: OPEN DAILY BEGINNING SATURDAY NOVEMBER 9TH, 2024 TO
SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 30TH, 2024, OPEN 1/2 HOUR BEFORE SUNRISE
TO 1/2 HOUR AFTER SUNSET. (SUBJECT TO EMERGENCY CLOSURE).

OTHER RESTRICTIONS: AS PER REG. #F24-024.

THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS SHALL BE IN EFFECT:

1. RELEASE ALL STEELHEAD.
2. ALL CATCH MUST BE REPORTED ON FISH TICKETS,
ROADSIDE SALE REPORTING FORMS, OR SUBSISTENCE CARD.
3. TRIBAL BUYERS MUST RETURN COMPLETED FISH TICKETS TO THE
FISHERIES OFFICE NO LATER THAN 6 DAYS FOLLOWING COMMERCIAL
HARVEST.
3. RETAINED FISH MUST BE MADE AVAILABLE TO TRIBAL FISHERIES
MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL TO COLLECT SURVEY INFORMATION.

4. FISHERS ARE PROHIBITED FROM TAMPERING WITH TRAPS
AFFILIATED WITH THE MAKAH GREEN CRAB PROGRAM.

JUSTIFICATION(S): TO ACCESS HARVESTABLE HATCHERY SURPLUS SALMON AND TO
PROTECT RETURNING STEELHEAD.
