NO COMMERCIAL SALE OF CATCH OR ANY PORTION OF CATCH ALLOWED UNDER THIS REGULATION;

PARTICIPATING VESSELS MUST NOTIFY THEIR NATURAL RESOURCES OFFICE PRIOR TO PARTICIPATING IN THE FISHERY.

JUSTIFICATION: HARVEST SOCKEYE SALMON FOR CEREMONIAL AND SUBSISTENCE PURPOSES, PER TRIBAL AND U.S. SECTION FRASER PANEL AGREEMENTS.
